What We Are and Our Purpose

Engage Estero (formally the ECCL) is an all-volunteer, nonpolitical, nonprofit Community Engagement
Association. Our purpose is to inform citizens of significant community issues and encourage citizen engagement to favorably impact the quality of life in greater Estero. We have influenced Estero's development over the last 20+ years and were instrumental in promoting the incorporation of the Village of Estero in 2015.



In a recent survey by Engage Estero, 75% of residents confirmed the need for a community based 501c3 nonprofit, nonpartisan, nonpolitical volunteer community organization.

The Need for Engage Estero & Estero's Rapid Growth

 Foundation, Estero Chamber of
 Commerce, and the Village of Estero to
 raise more than \$100,000 for

 hurricane Ian victims
- Helping the Estero Historical Society raise \$25,000 to contract for desperately needed repairs
- Establishing a successful Adopt a
 Highway program on US 41 and supported expanded litter cleanup in other locations

- Partnering with the Calusa Waterkeeper
 Organization, the Sanibel-Captiva
 Conservation Foundation, and the FGCU
 Water School to increase our impact in
 improving water quality and
 environmental issues
- Supporting the Metropolitan Planning
 Organization's initiative to establish a
 walking and bike trail system across
 multiple cities for recreational use
- Initiating a series of Public Forums, including water quality and environment, changes in community health, and planned building development
- Recruiting volunteers to continue the highly praised Junior Achievement program in Estero Schools
- Continuous monitoring of road and other Village capital improvement projects
